Programme

(identical for afternoon and evening sessions):

Both sessions will begin with three short talks

1. Putting Derbyshire's woodland in a national context (Natural England)
2. Woodland management for birds (RSPB)
3. An overview of funding for woodland management (Forestry Commission)

The rest of the session will be an informal opportunity for woodland owners to talk to representatives from various organisations about woodland management, the new England Woodland Grant Scheme (WIG 80), woodland birds and anything else woodland related.

Location:

The drop-in session will be held on the top floor of the Gothic Warehouse building, part of the Cromford Mills complex. The Gothic Warehouse is situated adjacent to the Derbyshire County Council's pay and display car park off Mill Road on the opposite side of road to the mill complex. Mill Road is accessible off the A6 at the traffic lights in Cromford.
